Attention senior parents: The FAFSA application is opening soon, and the HCP college team needs to ensure that they have all of the required information to assist your student in this part of their college process. If you have not already done so, ALL senior parents need to complete and turn in the first page of the FAFSA Information packet indicating how you plan to complete the FAFSA. This packet was given to parents at orientation and/or to students on the first day of class. If your student will be completing the FAFSA in class with their college seminar teacher, parents MUST fully complete the rest of the FAFSA Information packet and provide 2016 Federal tax returns and W-2 forms. The first page of the FAFSA packet OR the entire packet with the tax information is due ASAP but no later than Friday, 9/29/17. Contact a member of the College Team with questions.

Enrichment Registration Week: Enrichment Registration: Students must complete .25 enrichment credit hours per year in order to be promoted. Enrichment registration closed Tuesday, September 19, 2017. All hours are due Friday, January 19, 2018.
