**Enrichment Registration Week:** Students must complete .25 enrichment credit hours per year in order to be promoted. All students will have the opportunity to learn more about their top three choices after watching the video in advisory on Thursday, September 7th. Registration begins September 8th, 2017 and runs through Tuesday, September 19th, 2017. Students will receive a registration form from their advisors. The completed form, including **parent signature AND payment, are due to the DOS Office by Tuesday, September 19, 2017.** NO LATE FORMS WILL BE ACCEPTED; FORMS WITHOUT PAYMENT WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED. **Summer Community Service and Enrichment:** Documentation for 10th-12th grade community service and enrichment hours acquired over the summer starting June 15th to the start of the school year are **due by Friday, September 8th 4:00pm.** 9th grade students who attended Bengal Institute community service and enrichment hours acquired over the summer starting July 17th to the start of the school year are due by **Friday, September 8th 4:00pm.**

**LaSalle:** LaSalle is a silent, mandatory intervention implemented when homework for any subject has not been fully and satisfactorily the night before. Students who fail to serve their LaSalle the same day it was received will receive a detention. LaSalle can not be rescheduled. If a student knows he/she will have a prior engagement immediately after school, he/she will need to make sure his/her homework is complete the night before. LaSalle begins immediately after school and students are dismissed from LaSalle. LaSalle runs at the following times:

9th/10th Monday-Thursday: 4:10pm-5:00pm, Friday: 2:05pm-3:05pm

11th/12th Monday-Thursday: 4:05pm-4:50pm, Friday: 1:30pm-2:30pm

**Detention:** Detention is held Fridays from 8:00am-10:00am for 9th/10th grade and Thursdays 4:05pm-6:05pm for 11th/12th grade.

**Physical & Immunizations:** If your student has not submitted an updated physical and proof of immunization, he or she may be excluded from school. Please submit this information as soon as possible so your student can be in health compliance.
