- 11th graders: 30 total community service hours



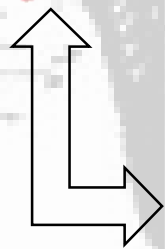
11th and 12th Grade Students

Students that are participating in Build Your Brand, Boot Camp may wear their Boot Camp or Build Your Brand t-shirts, uniform khakis with the uniform belt, and their choice of shoes.

These programs are designed to help our scholars build their SAT skillset ahead of the April 10th testing date for SAT as well as their college and career skills during a simulated job application and interview process in Build Your Brand.

Congratulations to all the IB 2018 exam candidates! We are excited to see your results. Just as a reminder, all IB seniors who are registered to test in May's exams will be charged a small fee as Hansberry is committed to our IB Diploma Programme and covers the majority of the testing costs which average around \$1200 per student. The following amounts per the IB Handbook that was distributed in the fall have been applied to the testing candidates accounts:

- **\$100** for students with free/reduced lunch status
- **\$200** for students receiving full-priced lunch
